Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to tell you that we are in the planning stages of an OPTIONAL trip for the cadets to Halifax, Nova Scotia. This trip will take place from Saturday March 9th to Sunday March 17th, 2019. To proceed with the planning of this trip, we will need to verify the number of cadets interested in attending.

For the first leg of the trip, the cadets will be travelling by coach bus to the 5th Canadian Division Support Base Gagetown in New Brunswick for a quick overnight stay and then onto the Regional Cadet Sailing School (Atlantic) – Mainbrace Complex at 12 Wing Shearwater, Nova Scotia for the week. The cadets will then be returning via the same route.

During their stay in Halifax, the cadets will spend a fun filled week involved in a variety of activities including museum tours, visits to a variety of military training facilities, travel to the scenic South Shore of Nova Scotia and the week will be top off with a tour of a Canadian war ship and the new CH148 Cyclone helicopters that replaced the outgoing CH124 Sea Kings.

The APPROXIMATE cost of this trip would be approximately \$490.00 per cadet. To help offset the cost of the trip, we have held and will be holding a variety of fundraising events that your cadet has the opportunity to participate in. Their effort in these events would reduce their personal cost of the trip to \$400.00.

To reserve a spot, we are asking you to please provide a cheque in the amount of \$100.00 per cadet made out to the Ottawa Branch of the Navy League of Canada and the form below no later than February 6, 2019. The deposit will be nonrefundable unless we are able to fill the spot with another cadet.
