The exercise will end at 2030 hrs on 17 March 2019 and the cadets will be transported by bus back to the Corps location. Parents will be updated en route as required.

NOTES:

1. Cadets **MUST** have their provincial OHIP card. Blue Cross insurance will be extended to the staff and cadets and a Blue Cross certificate number will be provided to Lt(N) Robert Lafrance prior to the commencement of the trip;
2. Prescription medications should be turned in to CI Nathalie Jacques for safe keeping with a schedule (inhalers and allergy needles exempt);
3. Put name on ALL personal belongings. Cadets are responsible for their own kit.
4. Junk food and snacks should be limited. Cadets will be properly nourished at all times.
