In addition to the cadets attending the training, there will be a requirement to staff each site with both CIC officers and staff cadets. Listed below are the staff requirements to support each site. For the OIC of each site, OSLA are looking for a Capt/Lt(N) who has experience in running multi-day activities. For the Platoon Commanders, OSLA will be prioritizing the employment of junior officers (NCdt/OCdt – SLt/Lt); however, they will consider Capt/Lt(N) if they do not have enough applications for these positions. For the staff cadet positions, OSLA will be looking at senior cadets who meet the requirements to be employed as a Staff Cadet, with these being our top senior cadets. The intention will be to employ personnel within their local area; however, there may be employment opportunities for CIC officers outside of OSLA at one of the other areas in the Central Region, if they are short people. On the application form there is a spot to indicate if you are willing to go outside OSLA on TD.

There is a staff application form that each officer and cadet who are interested in being employed for the CAP. This form is to be returned to our Zone Training Officer, Capt Johnston-Brown, **no later than Fri, 4 Dec 20**, with **selections completed no later than 18 Dec 20**. The CO has advised that in the event this activity is cancelled that all employment will still be honoured, where the selected personnel would be employed by the Area office in other capacities for that period.
